She has worked tirelessly to provide new bags, backpacks and duffle bags, for these kids. She started a non-profit organization called My Bag My Story, and to date they have provided nearly 900 bags for children in foster care. Her goal is to go national providing bags so that no child ever has to carry a trash bag and that kids carrying trash bags becomes a thing of the past.
